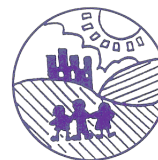

## The Victorians



## Class: Aspire

Teacher: Miss Wilton

## We are learning:

### Literacy (Reading and Writing)

**Phonics:** The children will practise their phonemes and use them in their reading and writing. Also they will explore the suffixes 'ful', 'ment', 'ed', 'er' and 'est',

**Poetry:** We will look at different word classes, using these to describe a Victorian Classroom experience.

**Pamphlet:** We will be looking at comparisons from the Victorian era to now.

**Story Writing:** We will be reading the Victorian Adventure and writing our own version of the story.

### Communication and Language

(Speaking and Listening)

Each child will have a perfect partner who they will talk to during discussions, problem solving and reasoning activities, to share their ideas with before they feed back to the class.

### Physical Development (PE)

We will be practising our gymnastic skills this term using a range of different apparatus and movements on gym mats

### PSED (Personal, Social and Emotional Development)

We will discuss the importance of staying safe on darker evenings and recap on tips to keep safe around Bonfire night.

Through our R.E. we will explore times of celebration and how these celebrations differ through religions.

Our learning is around the Victorian time period.

Our topic will begin with a day in a Victorian classroom!

### Expressive Arts and Design (Art,

D&T and Music)

We will be studying William Morris and his print technique to create a print in the style of William Morris.

We will be learning some Victorian songs, poems and rhymes.

We will be using silhouette painting to recreate a portrait of ourselves to replicate the Queen's profile on the first postage stamp, the Penny Black.

### Understanding of the World

(History, Geography, Science, RE, ICT)

We will be studying Queen Victoria and the Royal Family. We will compare our own families in a family tree.

We will investigate a range of Victorian inventions and order these chronologically on a timeline, in order to use this information in a pamphlet about Victorians.

We will compare aspects of Victorian life with our lives today looking for similarities and differences.
