We are learning:

Literacy *(Reading and Writing)*

Phonics: The children are split into groups to practise their phonemes and use them in their reading and writing.

Character description: Through our alien visit launch, we will create and describe our own alien character.

Non-fiction: We will explore planet facts and produce a fact file using the internet to search for information.

Diary entry: We will write a diary as an astronaut experiencing a trip to space.

Guided reading: We will begin guided reading for which we will share texts and answer questions based on evidence.

Communication and Language *(Speaking and Listening)*

Each child will have a perfect partner who they will talk to during discussions, problem solving and reasoning activities, to share their ideas with before they feed back to the class.

Physical Development *(PE)*

We will be practising our running, jumping, throwing and catching skills in games.

PSED *(Personal, Social and emotional Development)*

We will be discussing class rules and friendships as part of starting a new school year.

Our learning is around the topic 'Space'.

Our topic will begin by investigating an extra-terrestrial visitor!

Expressive Arts and Design *(Art, D&T and Music)*

We will be investigating the uses of everyday materials and choosing the most suitable one to build a rocket.

We will be learning space songs and poems.

We will use paint package computing software to create space pictures using tools such as fill, the paint brush and shapes drawing.

Mathematics

We will be learning our number bonds to 20 and reinforcing that addition can be done in any order.

We will be counting and ordering numbers beyond 100.

We will begin to understand the value of each digit in a 2 digit number (tens and ones) and will use this to begin to add 2 digit numbers.

We will be learning to count in steps of 2, 5 and 10.

We will be launching rockets and measuring and recording the distances travelled.

We will be learning the properties and names of 2D and 3D shapes.

Understanding of the World

(History, Geography, Science, RE, ICT)

We will be carrying out the following investigation: 'How much air power is needed to make a rocket travel 1 metre?'

We will be studying the first moon landing and the history of space travel.

We will learn about the basic needs of humans and apply this to inventing a space habitat.

We will be investigating the uses of everyday materials and the properties of these.
