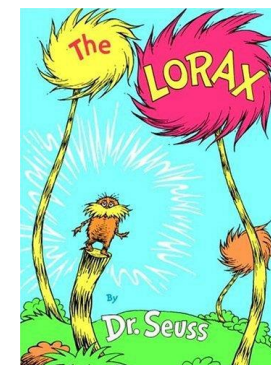

Maths

Perimeter and shape- We will be learning how to find the perimeter of shapes, along with following instructions to draw shapes with the correct perimeter ready to produce a map of the school.

Multiplication and Division- We are going to look at different ways to solve number problems involving both multiplication and division. We will also be working hard to master more of our multiplication tables.

Measurement (time)- We will be learning to tell and write the time from an analogue clock, including using Roman numerals from I to XII, and 12-hour and 24-hour clocks.

Addition and subtraction using money- We will be solving addition and subtraction problems involving money.

Physical Education

Swimming (Monday pm)- children will need to bring a towel and swimwear of a dark colour (one-piece for girls and swimming trunks for boys).

PE (Thursday pm)-

English

The Lorax- Dr Seuss- Read and study a story written by Dr Seuss. What would happen if someone cut all the trees down in our world?

Information leaflet – Read an information text about endangered forests and animals which reside there. Retrieve and infer from the text. Produce our own information leaflets about our own environment.

Poetry – Read traditional Christmas poems before writing our own, following structures and rhyming patterns throughout.

Art and Design Technology

We will be learning to observe and draw the landscape using sketching techniques. We will also be learning how to paint plants in the style of the artist Georgia O'Keeffe.

Music

This term we are going to be using our voices and playing musical instruments with increasing accuracy, fluency, control and expression. We will be learning some traditional Christmas carols ready for our Christmas concert at the end of term.

Science – Plants

We will be learning about plants, animals and their environments. We will be learning to label the parts of a plant and understand what specific plants need to survive. Can the same plants that grow in the rainforest grow in England?

We will be looking at the Eden Project and the different types of plants which grow there. What is a bio dome and how can we create our own?

Geography

We are going to learn how to use maps to locate different countries all over the world. We will also be learning about the different climate zones of our planet and how this affects the plants and animals which live there. Where are the forests and endangered species in the world?

Computing

We will be using the internet, safely and efficiently, to find more information about the forests and endangered species of our world, along with finding what we can do to help.

French

We will be learning how to say colours in French which will allow us to be able to speak about our personal experience. We will also be learning how to name objects in our classroom in French.
