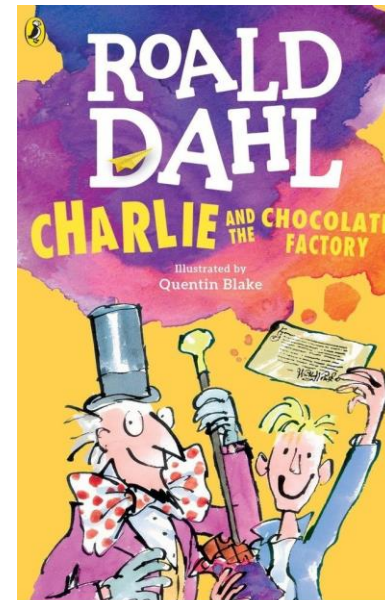

Maths

Statistics

This term in Maths we will be learning how to interpret and present data using bar charts, pictograms and tables. We will be using our research skills to find which type of chocolate bars people prefer and represent this data using all of the above methods first, and then use the information gained to create a healthy chocolate bar which we know the majority of people will like.

Shape, line and perimeter

We will be recapping our knowledge of shape, line and perimeter in order to design and create our own chocolate bar wrappers. We will then use our knowledge of multiplication to enlarge these designs.

Physical Education

P.E- In P.E we are going to be learning new skills which can be used in striking and fielding games, including rounders.

English

Charlie and the Chocolate Factory- Roald Dahl

We will be reading an extract from the well-known Roald Dahl book- Charlie and the Chocolate Factory. We will be studying the tools the author has used in order to capture the interest and imagination of the reader. We will use some of these ideas to recreate our own piece of descriptive writing.

Persuasive letter writing

We are also going to be learning how to successfully write a persuasive letter. We will be writing a letter to the owners of Cadbury to try and convince them to sell our amazing new healthy chocolate bar creations!

Our Learning is around the topic... Food, Glorious Food

Science

Whilst continuing to look at the importance of a healthy diet, we will be using our knowledge of this to create a healthy chocolate bar, which will include a variety of the vitamins and minerals which all humans need.

We will also be learning about light, reflections and how shadows are formed. We will use this to create our own shadow puppets inspired by Charlie and the Chocolate Factory.

Art & Design

During this term in Art we will be learning to improve their mastery of art and design techniques by studying and recreating some famous chocolate bar packaging. Closely looking at the fonts, colours and art work used will help us to create our own perfect packaging for the healthy chocolate bars we will be inventing this term.

Geography

We are going to be using a world map to locate the top cocoa growing countries and study their climate and environments, along with comparing them to our own.

French

We will widen our knowledge of how to name, ask for and describe foods in French. We will continue to work towards improving our conversational skills, using both speaking and listening skills.
