will earn a Castle Coin and 5 times per week will receive 2 Castle Coins**

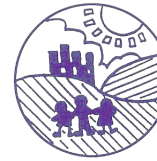
***Please record all reading in their reading record.***

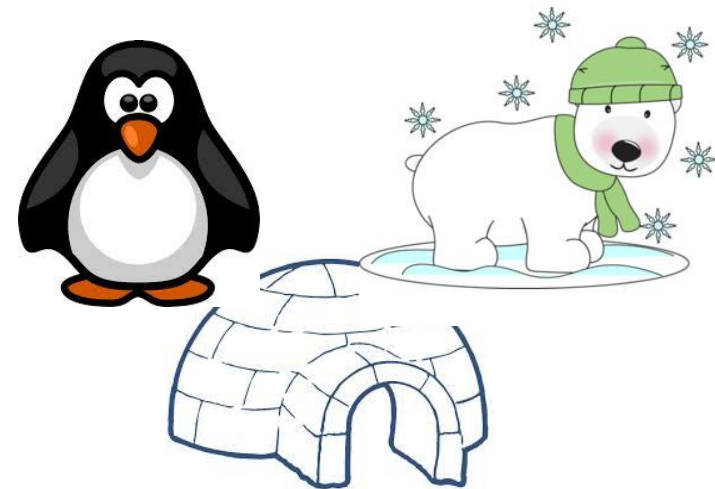
