will earn a Castle Coin and 5 times per week will receive 2 Castle Coins**

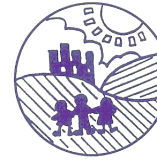
***Please record all reading in their reading record.***

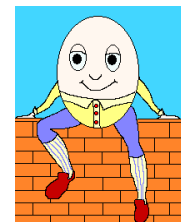

## Physical Development (PE)

- Holding a pencil using a tripod grip
- Holding scissors correctly and making snips in paper
  - Drawing lines and circles.
- **Putting on PE kit and uniform independently**
- **Making different body movements to match the story**
- **Using the correct letter formation in writing**

## Expressive Arts and Design

(Art, D&T and Music)

- Creating firework pictures using glitter
- Creating Humpty Dumpty using different modelling materials
- Making a spider from different modelling materials
- Making instruments and knowing the names and sound of different instruments around us
  - Christmas cards and crafts

## Literacy (Reading and Writing)

- **Phonics – Reception children will learn a new sound each day – reading and writing**
- Letter of the week – Nursery children – d g o c k
  - Topic related texts we will be sharing – Remember Remember the 5<sup>th</sup> of November, Humpty Dumpty, Incy Wincey Spider, Miss Polly has a Dolly and Old MacDonald had a Farm.
- **Reception – Name writing, Label Writing, Letter formation, Word writing through segmenting sounds and sentence writing.**

## Communication and Language

(Speaking and Listening)

- Learning new words through play and stories
- Building a wider vocabulary through play
- Answering who, where and why questions.
- Learning the names of different objects
  - Adding narrative to my play
  - Listening with increased attention

## Understanding of the World

(History, Geography, RE, ICT)

- Understanding how to stay safe near bonfires and fireworks
- Looking at different occupations - firemen
- Finding ways to protect Humpty Dumpty from his fall
- Using simple ICT equipment such as iPads to create different musical tunes
- Talking about and observing changes in the environment
  - Knowing how to take care of a baby
  - Understanding the Christmas story

## PSED (Personal, Social and emotional Development)

- Bonfire night safety, Firemen, calling 999
- Selecting resources independently
  - Working with others in class
- Sharing resources with our friends
- Talk about own needs and wants

## Mathematics

- Recognising numerals to 10
- **Writing numerals to 10 with the correct formation and orientation.**
- Counting to 10 and beyond
- Knowing the names of different 2D shapes
- Use and recognise Numicon pieces (Numicon is a maths resources that can be used in lots of different ways once children recognise the different pieces and their values)
  - Comparing different sizes
  - Sorting different animals by type
