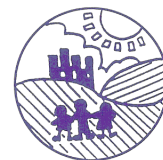

Class: Endeavour

We are learning:

Literacy *(Reading and Writing)*

Spelling and grammar: The children will be learning spelling, punctuation and grammar rules to apply to their reading and writing.

Adventure stories: We will be writing adventure stories based on *Kenzuki's Kingdom* by Michael Morpurgo.

Explanation text: We will be researching 'how to survive on a desert island' and writing an explanation text.

Biography: We will look at the life and work of Charles Darwin to support our understanding of evolution in Science.

Communication and

Language *(Speaking and Listening)*

Each child will have a perfect partner who they will talk to during discussions, problem solving and reasoning activities, to share their ideas with before they feed back to the class.

Physical Development *(PE)*

We will be collaborating and communicating with each other in 'outdoor adventurous' activity challenges focused around orienteering.

PSED *(Personal, Social and emotional Development)*

In our first term back at school we will be discussing class rules, learning behaviour and aspirations for the school year ahead.

Our learning is around the topic evolution, habitats and surviving on a deserted island

Our topic will end in a desert island shelter building challenge!

Expressive Arts and Design

(Art, D&T and Music)

We will be selecting from a wide range of materials and components in order to build a den or shelter for a deserted island.

Through our research on survival and evolution we will be creating observational drawings using line skills. We will explore using different media to develop colour within our drawings.

Mathematics

We will identify the place value of numbers with up to 8 digits and compare, order and round them.

We will be adding and subtracting whole numbers using the columnar method.

We will be exploring maps by: following coordinates, describing positions, drawing and translating shapes and reflecting them.

Using maps we will use scales and conversions to calculate distances and solve problems.

Through research on species and evolution we will be recording and interpreting statistics.

Understanding of the World

(History, Geography, Science, RE, ICT)

We will be exploring how living things have changed over time and how fossils provide information about what inhabited our Earth millions of years ago.

We will investigate how animals and plants have adapted to their environment and the advantages of this.

We will be looking at how the offspring of different animals vary in comparison to their parents.

We will be using different types of maps and location knowledge to locate the world's countries, climate zones, biomes, vegetation belts, rivers and weather patterns.
