the following Monday - this will be phonics based homework.

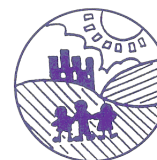
Reading - Reading books can be changed every day, if they have been read.

Please record all reading in their reading record.

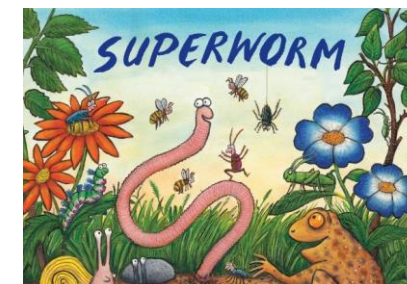

Physical Development (PE)

- Holding a pencil with the tripod grip
- Using tools for cutting
- Forming letters correctly
- Sewing a basket for Moses
- **Making different body movements to match the story**
- **Using the correct letter formation in writing**
- **Writing on the line**

Expressive Arts and Design

(Art, D&T and Music)

- Using a range of colours to design a pizza box and super hero cape
- Using different materials – clay
- Using different joining methods – glue, sticky tape, staples
- Using different media – vegetable printing

Literacy (Reading and Writing)

- **Phonics – Reception children will learn a new sound each day – reading and writing**
- Letter of the week – Nursery children – f, l, s, a, t
- Topic related texts we will be sharing – Super Worm, Super Duck, Super Daisy, Supertato.

- To understand about different occupations in life – Pizza Point visit
- To observe what a worm looks like and where they live
- To share different activities done outside of school with family and friends
- To use age appropriate software to draw a vegetable
- To know how to care for a seed/plant.

- Talk about own needs and wants
- Using negotiation to solve conflicts

Mathematics

- To use vocabulary related to size
- To use different shapes for a purpose
- Comparing the weight of vegetables
- Counting accurately
- Using language related to money

- Ordering items by weight, length and capacity
- To know the names and properties of 2D and 3D shapes
- Using money to buy items in our shop
