## Maths

### Money

This term we will be learning to put our addition, subtraction, multiplication and division skills to practice using money.

In particular, we will be using the four operations to find amounts of money to give change, using both £ and pence in practical contexts.

### Lines and Shape

We are going to concentrate on lines and shapes in terms of perpendicular and parallel lines, vertical and horizontal lines, along with describing both 2D and 3D shapes.

We will use the information learned during this topic to describe and make our own mini Anderson shelters, which will be similar to those used during World War II.

## Physical Education

Swimming (Monday pm)- children will need to bring a towel and swimwear of a dark colour (one-piece for girls and swimming trunks for boys).

P.E- In P.E we are going to be learning new skills which can be used in striking and fielding games, including hockey.

## English

### Goodnight Mr Tom

We will be reading the opening few pages of the well-known story Goodnight Mr Tom, which is set during World War II.

We will be concentrating on the genre features used by the author, including inverted commas (speech marks) and learning how to use these within our own writing.

### World War II Newspaper article

We are also going to be studying a newspaper article from World War II and again look at the specific genre features used in newspaper articles ready to recreate our own.

## Music

During our Music lessons this term we will be looking at the types of music and songs which were popular during 1939-1945. This will include singing, along with continuing to learn more about reading music both rhythmically and melodically.

## History

During this term we are going to be studying World War II. We will be looking at the reasons why the second World War was started and who was involved. We will learn all about life for people in England during WWII, in particular children.

### Geography

Following our topic for this term, we will be studying the location of countries which are significant to World War II on a map of the world and learning about their involvement during that time.

### Science

Rationing was a huge part of life during WWII and we will be learning all about nutrition and what humans need to survive.

### Art

During this term in Art we will be recreating some WWII art. We will be concentrating on colour selection, and creating depth and texture using paint. We are also going to recreate our own field of remembrance poppies, similar to those displayed in London as a tribute to all those who died during both the first and second World Wars.

### French

We will continue to learn descriptive language about ourselves but will also be learning how to ask for and describe a range of foods, linking to rationing during WWII.
